

BELL PULSE IQ



Bionet purchased 6 Mouse IQ boxes to trial, and as someone experienced with various digital traps like emitter and trapme, I must say that the Bell IQ is an impressive product. Its ability to track the last entry time of mice into the box and their frequency is particularly noteworthy.

During this week, I encountered a situation where the Mouse Bell IQ proved to be invaluable. We received a callout from a food retailer located on a busy high street, reporting a mouse sighting on the shop floor that had quickly scurried into the prep area. This particular site had no history of mouse infestation, leading us to believe that it was a random intruder that entered during the early morning delivery when doors were open.

After conducting a thorough inspection of the premises, we couldn't locate the mouse. To address the situation, we deployed rodenticide boxes and set up 3 Mouse Bell IQ stations with snap traps, in addition to 6 other boxes with snap traps. When we returned for a follow-up visit three days later, there were no further sightings and no signs of droppings. The traps and baits remained untouched.

However, the login data from the Bell IQ traps revealed that a mouse had passed through the boxes as recently as that morning in the early hours. Without the IQ boxes, we wouldn't have detected this activity, highlighting the valuable monitoring capability of the IQ system. I am scheduled to return to the site tomorrow, hoping to have successfully caught the mouse.
